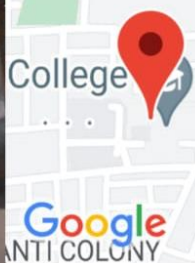

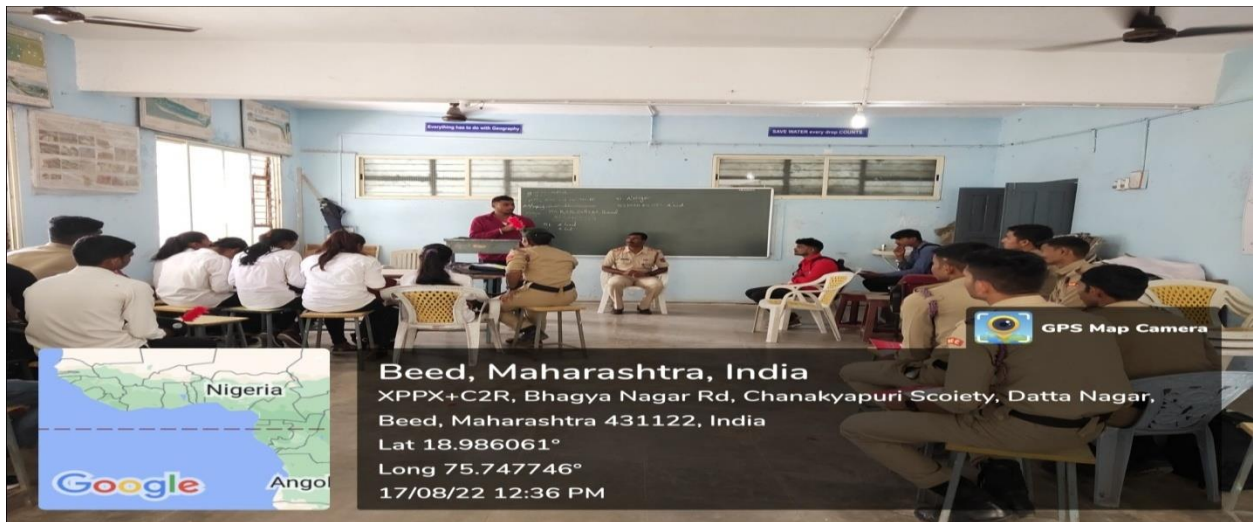

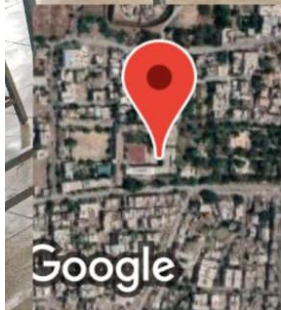
EVENT REPORT: READING INSPIRATION DAY

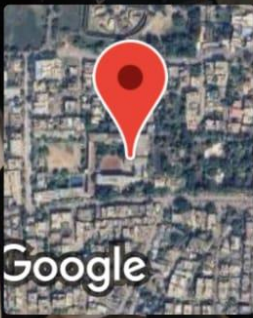
EVENT REPORT: GEOGRAPHICAL EXHIBITION

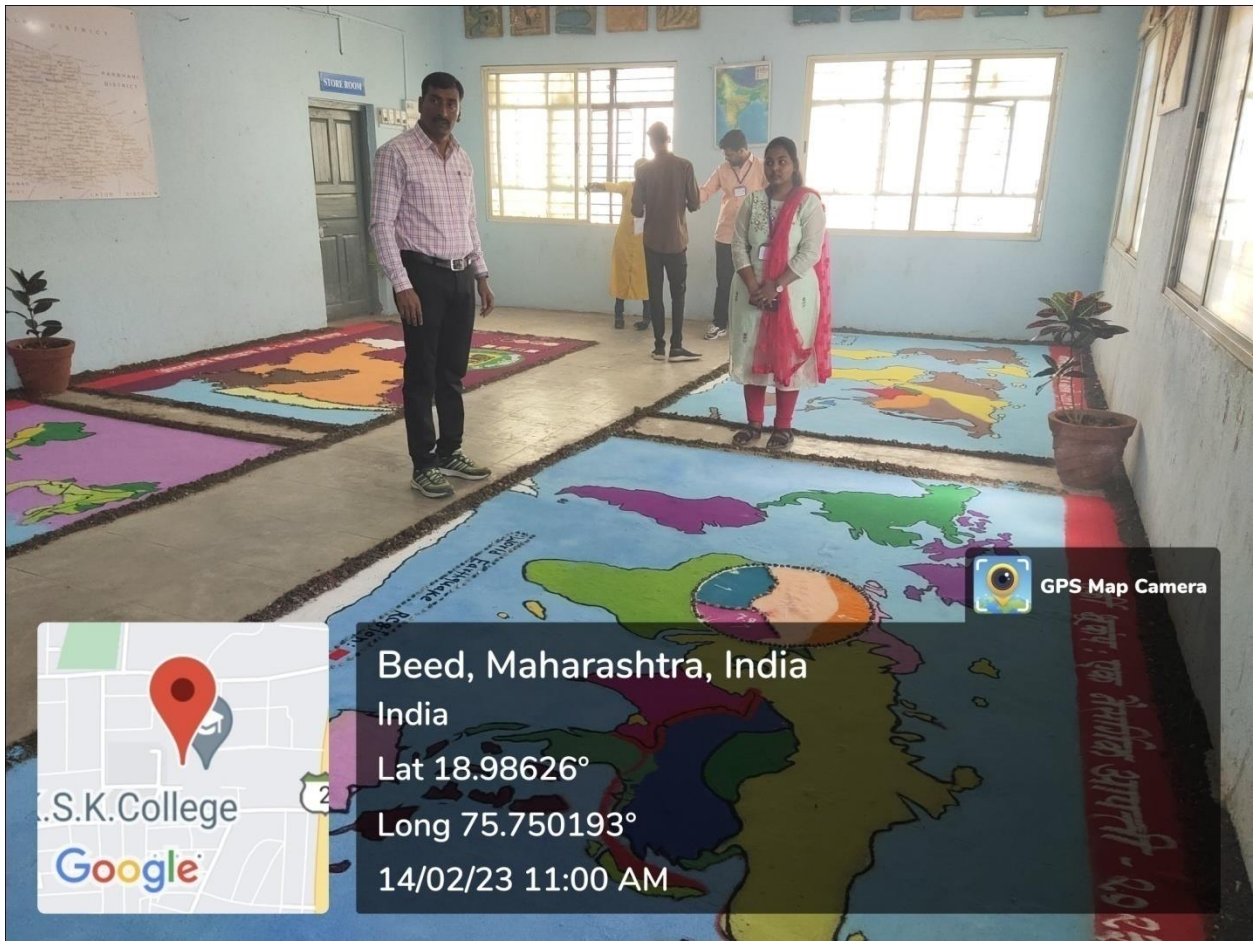


