Session- I

Inauguration of the exhibition-

Since this year is celebrated as International millets year-2023, an exhibition was organized by Sangita Gaikwad, KVK, Kharpudi, DistJalna. Wallpapers, slogans focusing importance, nutritive value and digestibility of millets and basket of various sweet and salty recipes prepared with millets were part of the 'Millet Exhibition'.

Anchoring of the session was done by Dr. P.R. Maheshmalkar

Inaugurator of national conference was honourable Professor ChetnaSonkamble, Dean, Faculty of Interdisciplinary studies, Dr.B.A.M.U. Aurangabad. In her speech she said that women enhancement is women empowerment. Concept of gender equality is well defined in the Indian constitution. Women empowerment is categorised in two ways: one is generalised and second is specific. Those women who had not any opportunity are in the generalised category, whereas those women who will be listened by society is specific type of women empowerment. For progress of nation empowered status of women is needed. Women empowerment is a gradual process. It is not coming through any separate Syllabus or academics. Years together Indians are observing this aspect. Kalpana Chawla, Malaya Yousafzai are the best examples of crossing the boundaries by women. Women these days are working in many sectors such as corporate sector, universities, schools, political sector etc. If a woman is educated whole family will be educated .woman these days may not be misused. That is men are ruling them. (i.e. Though the women are in the right position to take the right decision.) Women should adopt the sense of self-respect and confidence at home and at workplace too. People around women should not ruin women, even working woman and well educated woman is not having any scope to discuss in any financial matters like shareholding ,owning farms and houses or any investment issue. Everywhere she has to defend herself. Typical patriarchal system is deeply rooted in Indian society. It is sad to note that it's followed at present nationally and internationally. But, women have proved themselves. For example, Kiran Bedi, Indira Gandhi, Mother Teresa etc. Ability of women, education of women, participation of women and political will are important factors to enhance status of women in India. In recent years, the things are happening very positively but the rate is very slow. For that matter, mindset of woman herself has to be changed. Nurturing is the speciality of women gifted by nature. So medicine, child care ,nurseries , hospitals are the open fields for women. Challenge of gender equality is still present in India. Recognition of women is missing somewhere in the present .UGC has planned to implement NEP 2020 in a year or so, where there are efforts to promote gender equality and about eliminating gender discrimination.

Incharge Principal Dr.S.V.Kshirsagar informed chief about progress of College, mission and objectives of College.He also threw light on the new NEP-2020 and challenges for its implementation.He also reviewed various programs organised by Home Science and Sociology faculty .Lastly,he noted the importance of the topic of the National conference to the nation, state and family.

Topic: Women entrepreneurship and empowerment

Acknowledging that economic independence is the key to women empowerment, NCW aims to create a lasting impact for women across the country by providing women entrepreneurs access to knowledge and skills required to grow and sustain their entrepreneurial ventures.

Topic: Rural Status of women in India

Dr.Bhillare was the President of the session. While addressing participants, he focused rural women and girls. He spoke that the status of rural women reflects an even darker narrative. Out of 135 crore population in India, 65.13 percent live in rural setups and women constitute 48 percent of the total rural population. 74.8 percent of women are agricultural workers, but only 9.8 percent own a piece of land as per 2020 records. They are deprived of certain rights and opportunities and are required to wholeheartedly dedicate themselves to the implementation of household responsibilities. Rural women are at high risk of abuse, sexual harassment and other forms of gender-based violence.

The Anchor of the Session was Mrs. Sangita Gaikwad.

The Session was followed by lunch.

SESSION III

Pricipal Savita Shete

Topic: Gender Equality: Empowerment of Women and Girls

Pricipal Savita Shete delivered a lecture on gender equality. She said sex is biological but gender is not biological because it can be changed due to scientific advancement. Sexual organs are derived from chromosomes XX for girls and XY for boys. These days society is expecting too many things from brides such as well education, beautiful, handsome salaries and good packaged, healthier for doing household chores, calm and quiet by nature. Social system should adopt gender equality but since birth girls are facing from gender bias attitude and behaviour in India. Gender equality should start from home. One should be a human rather than a man or woman. Gender discrimination is high in India. Basic needs like cooking, washing clothes, and dishes, maintenance of cleanliness and hygiene of surrounding and following healthy habits should be taught to girls and boys in the family. Each woman must have same honour and respect as every man in family, community and society. She further said that girls and women are also responsible to widen the gap as they keep mum and tolerate the discrimination. This is the main reason that gender biased activities are happening more often in society. Highly educated and employed women are also suffering from discrimination in their families and at work places regarding caste, religion, and family rituals like keeping fasting inspite of her willingness. It is must for women to not to fear anyone. She also told about importance of different Indian laws noting that implementation is not proper. She advised participants to empower themselves to say no for anything which is against their will.

Prof.SandipChoudhary

Topic: 'Educational Status of Women, issues and concerns

Prof.SandipChoudhary delivered a lecture on the topic 'Educational Status of Women, issues and concerns'. While insisting about statistics of the topic, he said that nearly 5 million women are unable to read in India. Tribal people are having their mother tongue in which the school syllabus and teaching-learning is not available. So the education policy should be friendly towards them incorporating syllabus in their mother tongue. He suggested that NGOs, different organizations, schools and colleges should come forward to educate women and girls in an online mode and through informal education if they are having difficulty in attending scheduled formal school education.
